- Responsible for helping each child to become aware of their role as an integral part of the group.
- Responsible for the ordered arrangement, appearance, decor, and learning environment of the classroom.
- Contributes to the child care newsletters.
- Assists in the supervision and training of assistant teachers, teacher aides, work-study students and student interns.
- Reports and concerns for child abuse or neglect to the Director.
- Maintains confidentiality at all times.
- Performs all work in accordance with governmental laws, state mandates, Center policies and NYS OCFS licensing regulations.
- Other duties as assigned.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Graduation from a regionally accredited or New York State registered two-year college or university with an Associate's degree in early childhood education, child development or a child-related field and one year of teaching experience. Experience supervising staff. Current certification in First Aid and CPR required. If a candidate does not possess certification at the time of employment, the incumbent must obtain this certification within three months of the date of appointment. The incumbent must maintain valid certification for the duration of employment.
