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# Be One Of Us Scholarship

Non-NYS Residents have the opportunity to pay in state tuition through our Be One of US Scholarship! The Scholarship Program waives the non-resident portion of tuition to support non New-York resident students. This scholarship is administered through the Admissions Office. You must meet the following criteria to continue to qualify for the scholarship:

- Be a current TC3 student
- Maintain a 2.5. GPA
- <u>Live in TC3 Campus Housing</u> during <u>both</u> Fall and Spring semesters of your first year of enrollment at Tompkins Cortland Community College
- Perform and document 15 hours of <u>community service</u> each semester

#### Living On Campus

The on campus residence halls are a three-minute walk from campus, providing easy access to classes and other college facilities, such as, the library, pool, and fitness center. The complex offers apartment-style living with a private, locked bedroom for each person, a full kitchen and bath in each apartment, and an active community. Resident Assistants (RAs) and Residence Hall Council offer a variety of activities throughout the semester for students. #### Living Off Campus

Apartments for students are available throughout the community in a wide variety of locations and prices. Apartments are available in Dryden near the College's main campus. Others are located in Ithaca, Cortland, and surrounding towns and villages. Bus service is available between many of these areas and the College's main campus and extension centers. If you are considering living off campus, be sure to secure your housing prior to your arrival. It can be very difficult and expensive to find housing at the last minute.



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# International Student-Sponsor Payment Disclosure Form

By signing this form, we certify that we understand and accept the following conditions and agree to abide by them. As a condition of the student's admission, we agree to the following:

#### Student and Student's Sponsor:

- We understand that we are required to pay ALL tuition and fees by the designated payment deadline EACH semester. If we do not pay by the deadline date, the student's classes will be CANCELLED. If their classes are cancelled, they are in <u>USCIS</u> violation and their legal status will be terminated.
- This student will have available sufficient funds for tuition, fees and living expenses for each year of study at Tompkins Cortland Community College. We recognize that the cost of living is high, that financial aid from the College is not available and that international students are not permitted to work off campus. There may be limited on-campus employment; however, Tompkins Cortland does not guarantee employment. The chances of working on campus the first year are low and we understand that not all students who look for work will get a job. We understand that the sponsor is expected to cover my expenses for the entire duration of my schooling.

#### Student:

- I am responsible for knowing, understanding and abiding by the rules and regulations of being on a student visa in the United States.
- I authorize Tompkins Cortland Community College to release to any U.S. government officer information required to determine my compliance with U.S. immigration laws. Further, I understand the College will report all information required by the U.S. Citizen & Immigration Service (such as students who are not registered, are not pursuing a full course of study or are not meeting the minimum academic standards of the university.)
- I will arrive on or before the reporting date on my Form I-20 and attend the mandatory Orientation at the beginning of my first semester at Tompkins Cortland Community College.
- I declare that all the information I have submitted for my application is true, correct and complete.
- I understand I will comply with all of the requirements as stated on this agreement. I understand that falsification of any information will jeopardize the issuance of a Form I-20 and/or may result in Tompkins Cortland Community College revoking its decision to enroll me as a student.
- If I am a transfer student from another U.S. college or university, I will send an up-to-date, current copy of my Form I-20 to Global Initiates Office upon my arrival to Tompkins Cortland Community College.

#### **Choose Payment Option:**

- Set up a payment plan by the end of the third week of classes

Any student planning to live on campus housing, will be required to make the advance payment of \$250 deposit, and \$2500 to reserve their room when applying to housing.
