ELIGIBILITY

You are eligible for a Pathways Scholarship if:

- You reside in Cortland, Tompkins, or Tioga County
- You are 24 years of age or older when application is completed
- You have demonstrated financial need – as determined by filing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at FAFSA.ed.gov
- You enroll for at least six credits per semester
- You have never been a college student, *or you've been out of college at least five years, or you have earned or attempted 16 credits or fewer in the past five years*
- You have never earned a degree

TO APPLY

Here's how to apply for the Pathways Scholarship:

- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at www.fafsa.ed.gov. Even if you are working, you may still qualify for financial aid
- Apply for admission to Tompkins Cortland Community College at tompkinscortland.edu
- Complete the Pathways application form
- The Tompkins Cortland Community College Pathways Scholarship has dedicated support for you. HOW MUCH IS THE SCHOLARSHIP

- The maximum award is \$7,000
- Full-time students will receive \$1,750 for up to four semesters
- Part-time students will receive \$875 for up to eight semesters
- *This is in addition to any financial aid for which you qualify*
